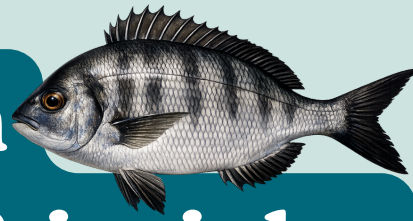

Maximum conservation reference size = 38cm



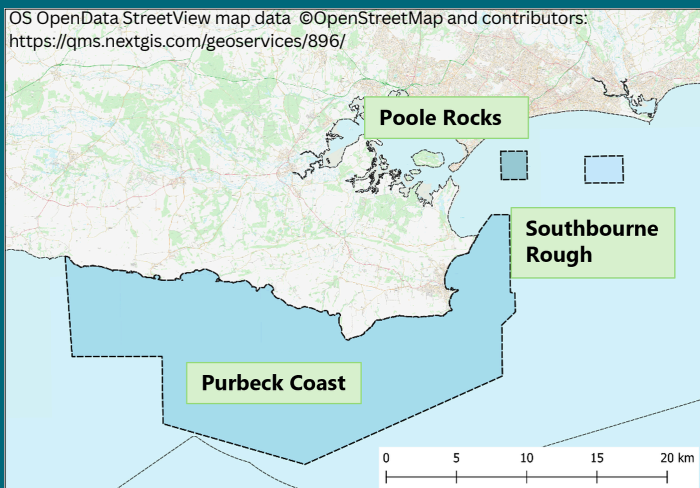
6 fish per person per day recreational bag limit

1st April to 31st July each year
