## FISHING FOR OYSTERS MUSSELS AND CLAMS

When fishing for oysters, clams and mussels in any fishery only the following methods may be used:

- a. Handpicking
- b. Dredging using a dredge with a rigid framed mouth so designed as to take shellfish only when towed along the sea bed. Shellfish may only be removed from the dredge when it has been hauled and lifted into the vessel.

This byelaw does not prejudicially affect any right of Several Fishery under the Sea Fisheries (Shellfish) Act 1967.
