OYSTER DREDGES

In dredging or fishing for oysters in any fishery no dredge shall be used which has a front edge or blade exceeding 1.5 metres in length and if two or more dredges are in dredging or fishing for oysters used at the same time in or from the same boat or vessel the total length of the front edges or blades of such dredges when added together shall not exceed 3.0 metres.

This byelaw does not prejudicially affect any right of several fishery under the Sea Fisheries (Shellfish) Act 1967.
