OYSTERS

- a) No person shall remove from a public or regulated fishery any oyster (other than Portuguese oysters and Pacific Oysters) which will pass through a circular ring of 70mm in internal diameter.
- b) No person shall remove from a public fishery any cultch or other materials for the reception of the spawn or young of any shellfish unless such removal is necessary for the destruction of pests or their spawn or of disease or is in accordance with established principles of oyster cultivation.
- c) Any such oyster cultch or other material for the reception of spat, which may be lifted while fishing or otherwise, the removal of which from a public fishery is prohibited by the above byelaws, shall at once be redeposited as nearly as possible on the same fishing ground.
