SOUTHERN INSHORE FISHERIES AND CONSERVATION AUTHORITY



REDEPOSIT OF SHELLFISH

Any person who takes any shellfish, the removal of which from a fishery is prohibited by any byelaw in force in the District, or the possession of which is prohibited by any Act of Parliament or Statutory Instrument shall forthwith redeposit the same, without injury, as nearly as possible in the place from which it was taken.

This byelaw does not prejudicially affect any right of several fishery under the Sea Fisheries (Shellfish) Act 1967.
