

Southern IFCA Net Fishing Byelaw



Gear Marking Guidance

Do I need to be aware of the requirements?

Yes, if you are <u>Net</u> Fishing; Recreationally or Commercially in the Southern IFCA District

What are the required conditions for gear marking?				
1	Any Net used within the district must be marked at each end by a <u>'marker Buoy'</u> (a floating object including a Buoy or Dhan) that is above the water so as to be clearly visible at all states of the tide.			
2	Markers must have a diameter of at least <u>210mm</u> .			
3	Markers must display <u>correct markings</u> as high above the water as possible as to be <u>clearly visible</u> and in a <u>colour contrasting with the surface</u> on which they are displayed as follows:			
IF:	You have a licenced vessel?	You have a non-powered or recreational vessel?		A vessel is not used in the fishing activity
	Port Letters and Numbers (PLN) of the vessel using that net	Name of the vessel using that net		Initials and surname of the person using that net
The letters and numbers displayed on the marker buoy shall not be effaced, altered or allowed to become illegible.
