# **BASS REGULATIONS**

<u>Commercial</u> – It is prohibited to retain bass in <u>February</u> & <u>March</u>. Outside of this closure, commercial vessels (subject to authorisation) may fish for, retain, tranship, relocate or land Bass using certain gear types and within limits (see MMO Bass Fishing Guidance for gear types and limits)

<u>Recreational</u> – Catch and Release **ONLY** in <u>February</u> & <u>March</u>. It is prohibited to retain Bass during this period. Outside of this period, **two Bass of at least 42cm** may be retained per person, per day.

Bass Nursery Areas – Fishing for bass or the use of sand-eels as bait from a boat is prohibited:

Between 30<sup>th</sup> April – 1<sup>st</sup> Nov - Chichester Hbr, Langstone Hbr, Portsmouth Hbr, S'oton Water, Poole Hbr All year at Fawley Power Station and The Fleet

### CLOSED AREAS - see full byelaws for coordinates and maps of closed areas

Bottom Towed Fishing Gear Byelaw – defined closed areas throughout the District.

**Hand Gathering** – seagrass beds throughout the District (all year/seasonal)

**Trawling** – within 1 nautical mile of Chesil Beach – Closed 1<sup>st</sup> May to 31<sup>st</sup> August

**Net Fishing –** Prohibited, Restricted & Permit Areas across the District.

#### **CLOSED SEASONS**

Oysters (Native) - throughout District - Closed 1st March to 31st October

Periwinkles - throughout District - Closed 15th May to 15th September

Cockles - throughout District - Closed 1st February to 30th April

Prawns (Poole Harbour) – Closed 1st January to 31st July

# **NET FISHING BYELAW** – See full byelaw for coordinates of areas

**Net Prohibition Areas** – a person must not use a net.

**Net Permit Areas** – No netting unless authorised by Permit. Permit Conditions Apply. **Net Restriction Areas**:

- -Ring Net Only all year L'stone Hbr, East Fleet, Wareham Appr Restriction Areas
- -Ring Net Only 1 Mar 31 Oct P'mouth Hbr, Poole Hbr Restriction Areas
- -C'Church Box Ring Net only 15 Feb 30 Sep. Bottom Set / Ring Net 1 Oct 14 Feb
- -Lyme Bay Restriction Area no netting within 3m of surface

#### **COMMERCIAL FISHING**

Any vessel fishing **commercially** in the District must be registered with the Authority.

The **maximum size of vessels** allowed to fish commercially in the Southern IFCA District is 12 metres overall length.

# SHELLFISH RESTRICTIONS

**Solent Dredge Permit Byelaw** - A Solent Dredge Permit is required to use a dredge in the Solent. *Closures and Permit Conditions apply* 

**Poole Harbour Dredge Permit Byelaw** – A Permit is required to use, retain on board, store or transport a dredge in Poole Harbour. *Closures and Permit Conditions apply.* 

**Scallop Fishing** – a maximum of 12 dredges may be towed at any time. Dredges must be fitted with a spring-loaded tooth bar. Mouth of dredge must not exceed 85cm width. No more than 2 tow bars may be used. Length of tow bar shall not exceed 5.18m. No person shall fish for/take any scallop **before 0700 and after 1900** (in the Solent prohibited timings are before 0600 and after 1800).

Fishing for Oysters, Mussels and Clams – by handpicking or dredging only

**Redeposit of Shellfish** – shellfish taken in contravention of a byelaw, must be deposited as near as possible to where it was taken, without injury.

**Electric Current** – No person shall take or kill any sea fish by the discharge of electric current.

**Foul Hooking** – No person shall use any instrument or device for the purpose of foul hooking (posterior to eyes) any mullet or bass.

**Berried Lobsters** – No person shall remove any berried lobster or any lobster with a notch cut in its tail or a mutilated tail.
