

Beckton Lake Angler's Card

1. A Beckton Lake Angler's Card is required to fish at Beckton District Park North only. No day tickets are issued.
2. The Beckton Lake Angler's card is currently free of charge to obtain, but if a replacement is required there will be a charge of £10.
3. On receiving the card, each person will produce a valid Environment Agency rod licence, identification and a passport photo.
4. The Beckton Lake Angler's Card will last 12 months, from April 1st – March 31st and be renewed annually.

Rules & Code of Conduct

5. Any Beckton Lake Angler's Card holder observed not abiding by rules by an officer of the Council will result in immediate confiscation of your angler's card.
6. Anglers must carry their Beckton Lake Angler's Card at all times when fishing at Beckton District Park North, and must produce when asked to do so by any representative from Newham Council, Active Newham, Met Police officer, Environment Agency or other card holder.
7. Fishing is permitted only during park opening times (see below), no night time fishing is permitted. No person is permitted to enter the park before official opening of the park, or remain in the park after closing. Breach of this will result in immediate confiscation of your Beckton Lake Angler's Card and a 1 year banning order.
8. All card holders must cooperate with Council park locking teams and leave the park immediately when requested.
9. All anglers must abide by London Borough of Newham Bylaws. Anybody not abiding by LBN Bylaws will be given an anti-social behaviour contract and asked to leave the premises. LBN reserves the right to ban individuals from the location permanently.
10. Any anglers issued with an anti-social behaviour contract, who breach the stated conditions, will be liable for further action.
11. The principles of fair and lawful fishing will guide all aspects of club operation.
12. Under 12s must be accompanied by a responsible guardian (18 years or over) at all times.

Equipment

13. Unhooking mat and suitable landing nets must be used at all times.
14. Back leads must be used at all times.
15. No keep nets to be used.
16. Nuts of any kind are not to be used as bait.
17. Floating baits of any kind are not to be used.
18. No live baiting.
19. No tins or disposable bait containers are to be taken into the park.
20. Line baiting of any kind not to be used.
21. Anglers are limited to two rods.
22. No person is permitted to erect a tent in the park.

Health & Safety

23. Anglers are not permitted to wade into the lake.

24. No litter is to be left in or around lake. Should littering be witnessed you will be liable for a fine of £80.
25. No fires to be lit anywhere in the park.
26. No alcohol to be consumed on site. This will be subject to further action i.e. banning order.
27. No controlled substances to be consumed on site. This will be subject to further action i.e. banning order.
28. No fishing on the beach or waterfall areas of the lake.
29. No fishing from footpaths.

Wildlife Welfare

30. Fish must be checked for damage and health and immediately returned to water once unhooked.
31. Any sign of misconduct, harm to wildlife or anti-social behaviour must be reported to police non-emergency number 101.
32. No person shall in the ground intentionally kill, injure, take or disturb animals or fish or engage in hunting or shooting or the setting of traps or nets or the laying of snares.
33. All members must respect properties. No fires, radios, bad language, fighting, litter, ill-treatment of birds, fish or other wildlife is allowed.

Obstruction

34. No person shall in the ground:
 - (a) Intentionally obstruct any officer of the Council or Police in the proper execution of their duties;
 - (b) Intentionally obstruct any other person in the proper use of the ground, or behave so as to give reasonable grounds for annoyance to other persons in the ground.
 - (c) Shall refuse to leave the park when directed
