- Experience of the breadth of the primary curriculum
- Motivation and good humour to meet the challenges or working with pupils with special educational needs
- Calm and consistent approach when working with children
- Ability to build children's confidence and self esteem
- Proven ability to work as part of a team and form good relationships with children and adults
- Enthusiasm and willingness to learn
- Ability to work on your own initiative
- Adaptability to the changing needs in the classroom and a flexible approach to working
- GCSE Grade C or above in English and Maths
- Ability to communicate clearly and effectively both verbally and in writing
- Good ICT skills
- Ability to support children in learning suitable strategies for maths, reading and writing up to Year 6
