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I have been an NHS GP for over 20 years. I remain appraised and revalidated on the GMC register. I have worked in a variety of General Practice settings including as a GP Principal (for 8 years), Locum work in Practices (for 12 years), out-of-hours care, urgent GP care (including within A&E), telephone triage, covering a Cottage Hospital, looking after patients in Nursing and Residential Homes and looking after private patients. I am currently a long-term freelance GP with a Practice in Hampshire and I continue to do urgent care shifts. Prior to that I was a partner in a 10,000 patient NHS Training Practice in Guildford for 8 years.

I have frequently taught and supervised medical students, Foundation Year Doctors and Specialist GP Trainees years 1, 2 and 3. I am ex-chairman of the South West Thames faculty of the Royal College of General Practitioners and I sat on the executive committee for General Practice postgraduate training for Kent, Surrey and Sussex Deanery for 9 years. I have also sat on the Guildford and Waverley Clinical Commissioning Group Council and on the joint GP revalidation board helping GPs through the educational requirements of the GMC revalidation process.

In 2010, I was nominated 'clinical champion' for integrated healthcare in Surrey.

I am a Fellow of the Royal College of General Practitioners, gained by assessment and a Fellow of the Expert Witness Institute, one of the roles of which is mentoring new members.

I teach medico-legal matters to GPs at update courses and I regularly run a course, training aspiring expert witness as well as established expert witnesses on dealing with the litigation process and on their obligations to the Court. I also give regular topic talks to Solicitors and Claims handlers at NHS Resolution and for NHS Wales.

I am author of the Primary Care Chapter of the 6th edition of Powers and Barton 'Clinical Negligence' 2023.

- Having provided expert opinion on over 6000 alleged medical negligence cases for Claimant and Defendant in equal measure, I have become very accustomed to considering what is reasonable versus unreasonable treatment by a responsible body of General Practitioners and most importantly what is within the range of reasonable practice and what is outside that range.
- My opinion has been offered at a variety of levels including High Court, Crown Court, County Court, Court of Protection, Coroner Court and GMC Fitness to Practice cases.
- I have a particular niche in Inquests and I am regularly instructed as the Coroner's expert by various Coroners throughout England including the jurisdictions of North London, Inner London South, Walthamstow, Surrey, Kent, Isle of Wight, Portsmouth, Cambridge, Cornwall and Hull and East Riding. I have given oral expert evidence at Inquests on over 70 occasions.
- I have also given oral evidence in five civil litigation trials and one criminal trial.
- I comply with the Civil Procedure Rules 1998 (revised Oct 2009) and have extensive experience working with the principles of the Test cases of Bolam (Eng and Wal) modified by Bolitho, Bailey (Eng), Hunter (Scot) and Dunne (Ire) and the Montgomery Test.
- I produce approximately 400 alleged medical negligence reports per year, for Claimant and Defendant in close to equal measure; 40% Defendant, 50% Claimant and 10% other (for example General Medical Council Fitness to Practice, CPS, Police and various Coronial jurisdictions).
