Subsidised heating oil tank replacement

Your property is located in a high risk area for groundwater contamination. This groundwater is used for public water supply.

If you use and store heating oil on your property for domestic use, is your tank and ancillary pipework:

- in poor condition?
- · over 20 years old?
- a single skinned tank?

If your tank or pipework meets any of these criteria and poses a risk to groundwater, Portsmouth Water is offering a 50% subsidy (capped at £2,500) for any works to make your heating oil set-up low risk to groundwater. This can include tank replacement, pipework replacement and the installation of an appropriate concrete base.

All works will be carried out by an OFTEC registered technician nominated by Portsmouth Water.

This offer is subject to the discretion of Portsmouth Water. A risk to groundwater must be present for funding to be approved.
