## Welcome to Abbeyfield Yarmouth

'The Coach House' Abbeyfield in Yarmouth opened in March 1998 to provide homely, supported living accommodation for ten residents with low dependency care needs who can look after themselves and their rooms, with cleaning provided, in an atmosphere of **care, companionship** and **support**.

We benefit from a tranquil location in the beautiful historic town of Yarmouth, just a short walk from the Castle, Harbour, High Street, Pier, seaside walks, Wightlink ferry and regular bus services to Newport, Freshwater and beyond.

The House is arranged so that each resident has their own **personal and secure** accommodation with free **WIFI** and an emergency **WightCare** Call Button system provided.

**Ensuite bedrooms** with **showers**, are warm, with carpeted living area, peacefully decorated and furnished with each resident's chosen possessions, including artwork, curtains, bedding, and lounge furniture. Each room has a **Fridge, Microwave, Toaster** and **Kettle** and private **telephone** line.

The House Cook provides hot cooked **lunches** and light **evening meals** based on residents' own dietary requirements in our **Dining** room. Residents arrange their own **breakfast** and daily snacks.

There are **stair lifts** to give access to both the first floor rooms and our beautiful **garden patio** area with easy access ramps, seating areas and **Summer House**. Our **Conservatory** is light and airy. We also have a comfortable **lounge** with **Satellite TV, Drinks Bar** and quiet **Library room** for residents.

An onsite **Laundry** and secure lift **assisted bathing** room are available to residents.

Free onsite **Car parking** for residents and visitors, with charging points and secure storage for **electric mobility** scooters.

There are few House rules for our residents other than those of **common courtesy**; they are free to come and go and receive visitors.

A Hairdresser, Chiropodist, Physiotherapist, Personal Carers and community nurses visit along with Singing, Yoga, Pilates and Dance instructors. In-house activities including quizzes, crafts and games and accompanied outings to the Islands' varied attractions are organised.

Our consistent aim is to alleviate loneliness and increase companionship for those aged 55 years plus. on a daily basis to have more time to live their lives in comfort.
