Terms and conditions:

- Registration fee $£ 30.00$ (includes pre-visits and paperwork set-up)
- Deposit of $£ 150.00$, this is non-refundable and will contribute towards last month's fees.
- Minimum of 2 sessions per week to provide consistency and to help your child to settle.
- $10 \%$ discount for second child
- Funding available for 2, 3- and 4-year-olds. Funding offered term time 15 or 30 hours and all year round at 11 or 22 hours per week, please see session options.
- 2-year-old funding can be applied for online, or a Manager can carry out an assisted application for you, confirmation letter must be provided.
- New 2-year-old funding ( 15 hours) and the 30-hour funding (3-year-olds) can be applied for online using childcare choices, this is for working families and if eligible you will be provided with an 11-digit code that the Manager will need to verify along with your NI number, this must be renewed every 3 months and within deadlines. New 9 month old funding is applied for in the same way and begins the term after your child turns 9 months, this begins in September 2024.
- To claim 15 hours as a 3-year-old, you do not need to apply.
- Fees payable 51 weeks of the year regardless of closures or bank holidays. One free week is applied during the Christmas closure, although we are closed for approximately 10 days. If you decide to go on holiday or your child is off sick, fees still have to be paid 51 weeks of the year.
- Late fee and late collection charges apply outside of agreed hours.
- Nappies included are usually Asda or Tesco (supermarket) own brand, if you require a specific type you are welcome to bring in your own.
- All voucher, student finance and tax-free childcare payments accepted.
- All fees paid a minimum of a month in advance, payable by last working day for the month ahead.
- A months' notice is required for your child to leave or change hours/days.
- Fees normally change/increase yearly.

## Nursery fees and session times for funded only places:

Funded children only, must choose one of the following sessions and if they require any additional hours may top up using the hourly rate of $\mathfrak{£ 6 . 5 0}$. Hourly rates cannot be overlapped into a new session, for example, if you choose 8:30am-11:30am, you can pay for an additional hour from 7:30-8:30 and 11:30-12:30 (plus any consumable charges) but you cannot choose to pay 2 hours from 11:30-1:30. If your session is $8: 30-4 \mathrm{pm}$ and you want to stay until $\mathbf{6 p m}$ it will cost an additional $£ 13.00$. For additional days you pay the main nursery rates on the first page.

Funding starts the term after your child's birthday and proof of eligibility will be required for 9 month olds, 2 -year olds and 30 hours.
