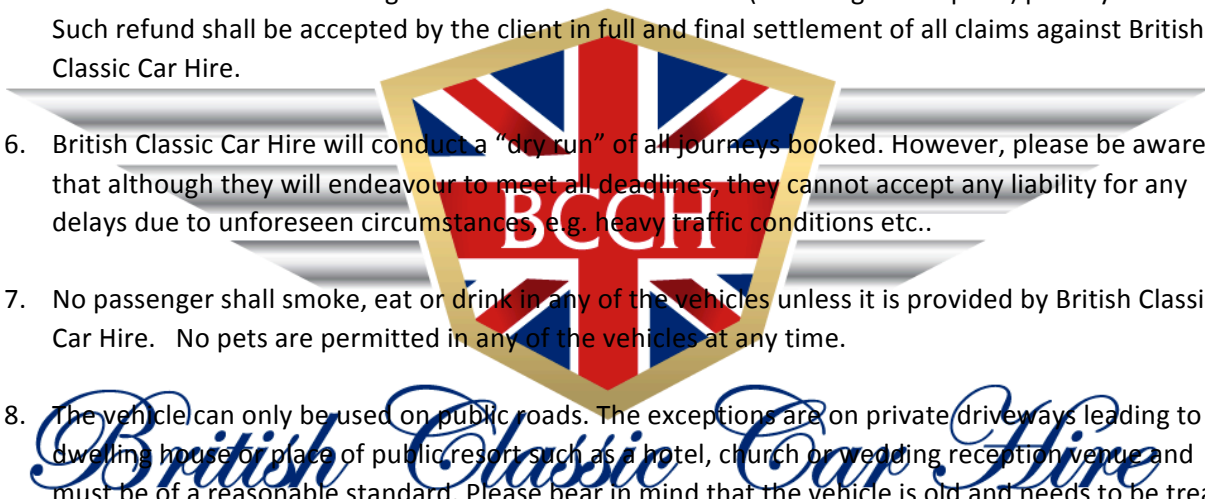


## TERMS & CONDITIONS OF HIRE

1. Clients are advised to inspect the vehicles before entering into this contract. If the client wishes to book without viewing the vehicle/s, British Classic Car Hire accept no responsibility to the client if the vehicle/s hired are not as expected by the client.
2. British Classic Car Hire will allocate cars for specific dates upon request, however will only be confirmed as reserved when the £50 per vehicle deposit is received. The deposit is non-refundable.
3. British Classic Car Hire will invoice the client for the balance payable. The balance shall be paid no later than 30 days prior to the event, failing which the contract will be cancelled. Bookings made within 60 days of the hire date require payment in full at the time of booking.
4. Cancellations must be received in writing. In the event of this contract being cancelled within 30 days (before the hire date) the full outstanding hire charge will be due.
5. In the unlikely, but possible event of a mechanical failure of a vehicle booked, or for any other bona fide reason, British Classic Car Hire reserves the right to substitute a vehicle with another from their fleet, depending upon availability. The client will have the option, in this instance, to terminate this contract and will have the right to a full refund of all sums (including the Deposit) paid by the client. Such refund shall be accepted by the client in full and final settlement of all claims against British Classic Car Hire.
6. British Classic Car Hire will conduct a "dry run" of all journeys booked. However, please be aware that although they will endeavour to meet all deadlines, they cannot accept any liability for any delays due to unforeseen circumstances, e.g. heavy traffic conditions etc..
7. No passenger shall smoke, eat or drink in any of the vehicles unless it is provided by British Classic Car Hire. No pets are permitted in any of the vehicles at any time.
8. The vehicle can only be used on public roads. The exceptions are on private driveways leading to a dwelling house or place of public resort such as a hotel, church or wedding reception venue and must be of a reasonable standard. Please bear in mind that the vehicle is old and needs to be treated with care. Please also be aware that whilst the vehicle is kept in excellent condition, it will inevitably have a few rattles and squeaks not present in modern cars.
9. Photographs can be taken at any time and we are more than happy to stop at any venue of your choice along the route to accommodate this.
10. We are only responsible for loss or damage to personal property left in the vehicle if the loss or damage results from our negligence.
11. The car will be delivered in a polished and clean state on the hire date to the address given below. British Classic Car Hire do not accept any liability for clothing becoming marked or stained by oil/grease, road dirt or exhaust fumes from the vehicle.
12. In the event of any internal or external damage being caused to a vehicle by the client, the client's guests, or any other party, the client will be liable for the full cost of the refurbishment. British Classic Car Hire expects all passengers to behave without fault and reserve the right to terminate a
