We have recently completed transparency formalities and registered with the Commission as a stakeholder, in relation to F'Gas legislation and therefore are able to lobby the Commission, as early as possible, for any proposed changes to legislation. A recent document was published entitled "**REPORT FROM THE COMMISSION – on availability of training for service personnel regarding the safe handling of climate friendly technologies, replacing or reducing the use of fluorinated greenhouse gases"**.
