Important Information

Water bottles

Please can we remind you that drinking bottles must contain water only. Bottles will be checked and if necessary emptied and refilled with water.



Clothing

Could you please ensure that all clothing, including pumps, coats and wellies are all named and that they are appropriate for the time of the year. Thank you.



Reporting Illness

Remember that if your child is ill, please phone the pre-school on 0118 9568528 or 07484 853891 to report the illness. If your child has been vomiting, they should not return to pre-school for 48 hours after the last time they have been sick.

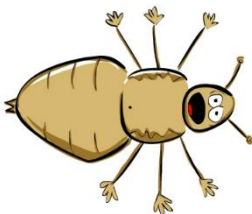
If it is necessary to give your child Calpol to reduce their temperature, they are not well enough to attend pre-school.

Medicines

To administer medicines to your child a consent form must be completed before hand. All medicines must be brought into pre-school with a named prescription label on each item. Unprescribed medicines are not able to be given in pre-school.

Toileting Accidents

Children may be capable of going to the toilet but accidents are still likely to happen and must be expected, often simply because they are so engrossed in their play that they forget to go.



Head Lice

Please be prepared for your child to come into contact with head lice. Long hair should be tied back to reduce the risk of infection. We have leaflets available giving you guidance on how to check and treat.

Injured Children

Please can you explain to your child that if they injure themselves or another child hurts them at pre-school they need to tell a teacher. We are watchful at all times but on occasion, things do happen that we do not see. If your child has hurt themselves at home please let a member of staff know, you may be required to fill out a form.

Toys Going Home

Please don't be embarrassed about toys being taken home by your child. All we ask is that you return them to us.
