


BEACHY HEAD EAST MARINE CONSERVATION ZONE



Sussex Inshore Fisheries and Conservation Authority is currently consulting on a proposed Beachy Head East Marine Conservation Zone Schedule 5 to the Sussex IFCA Marine Protected Area Byelaw

Beachy Head East MCZ, designated in 2019, is the largest MCZ within inshore waters covering an area of 195km2. The Authority has a responsibility to introduce appropriate fisheries management for the area of BHE MCZ inside Sussex IFCA District (192km2). The proposed Marine Protected Areas Byelaw 2023 Schedule 5 will protect sensitive species and habitats by introducing a zonal management approach, including exclusion of 'towed-gear' from part of the site.
