
Sussex IFCA Guide for Fishers: Tag locations for different types of fishing gear



- 1. **General Notes**. The tag must be placed on the outside of the pot and must be in a position where it can be clearly seen by inspecting officers. Below are locations where the tag should be displayed on various types of pots and traps.
- 2. **Parlour pots**. The tag on these types of pots should be placed on the main frame of the pot near the door/flap. It will be protected to some degree if rolled on the sea bed and shouldn't get in the way of emptying the catch.





3. **Inkwell pots**. The inkwell pot is more stable as it has a wider base and therefore top of the inkwell is a good point to place the tag, it should be placed through the mesh and around the frame for security.





4. **25 litre drum whelk pots**. The handle of these drums is the ideal place as it doesn't interfere with emptying your catch or storage.



5. **Upright Whelk Pots**. Tags should be placed on the side of the pot and preferably near the top.





6. **Cuttle traps.** The top of the traps is the preferred location, unhindered in any way and doesn't interfere with storage.
