

The Sea Angling Diary Project is for English and Welsh sea anglers to help improve the sustainable management of marine stocks and demonstrate the value of sea angling.

The project has helped to report the activity, catches and economic and social value of recreational sea angling since 2016 which is used to inform better decision making about sea angling's future.



Diarists record their sea angling sessions and catches each month via an online website tool or a mobile app. Over 2,000 sea anglers take part every year – join them now and discover some great benefits!
