Theatre for Life is committed to combating discrimination through the promotion of equal opportunities in respect of:

- Provision of services
- Working practices of the organisation

Theatre for Life will try to ensure that in respect of the above, no young person shall receive less favourable treatment than others because of her or his:

- Gender, including gender reassignment
- Religious belief or political opinion
- Race (including colour or ethnic origins)
- Nationality
- Disability
- Sexual orientation
- Educational background

At Theatre for Life CIC we want to work with young theatre makers from disadvantaged backgrounds and who have limited access to the arts.

We work with young people from the most disadvantaged communities in Southampton to create inspiring and engaging opportunities within the arts.

If you are an aspiring theatre maker aged 14 -25 years old please register your interest if you meet one or more of the following eligibility criteria:

**Facing social or financial hardship, receipt of Income Support, or Universal Credit in place of Income Support, in their own right, in receipt of Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit and Disability Living or Personal Independence Payments in their own right, in recipient of Free School Meals.**
