Description

The Young Women's Christian Association of Kenya, (YWCA) is the oldest women's organisation in the country, having been founded in 1912. The Association seeks to improve the living conditions of women and girls in Kenya through social and economic empowerment as well as programmes aimed at addressing health, water, sanitation, and basic rights. Located in central Nairobi in Upper Hill, just north of the Central Business District, the YWCA has the opportunity to unlock the value in their property, through commercial development of their facilities. The development will be mixed facilities including serviced apartments, high end residential properties and student accomodation.

 - Addressing issues of gender equality at community level


