Predominantly Pinot Meunier, balanced with Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, with light bubbles and as fruity palate

Picpoul de Pinet, L'Ormarine 2018 France 26.00
A fresh and fruity wine from the Mediterranean coast of Languedoc. Excellent with grille fish and seafood

Chablis, Pascal Bouchard 2016 France. 42.00
Full of ripe peach flavours but with a distinct mineral refinement from the stony austerity of the fossil soils.

Sancerre, François Millet 2016 France. 43.00
Lime and lemon zest are supported by an herbaceous tang, which includes sage & thyme, deliciously sappy finish.

Pouilly Fuisse, Les Vieux Murs, Jean Loren 2014 France 65.00
Hints of honey and candied mirabelle. This Pouilly Fuisse comes from south of Macon. A perfect wine for seafood
