

Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 course overview

The Uniq 11+ course is designed to be developmental, allowing us to start working with students whilst they are in Year 4 and develop the range of skills which are needed to be successful in this challenging assessment. As the course progresses, the focus will change. In the early stages we will focus on developing the knowledge base for our students, whilst as the course progresses we will also incorporate work on developing examination technique.

The different stages of the course are outlined below;

Year 4 Weekly 2 hour sessions throughout the school year (Approx 30 sessions)

Year 5 Weekly 2 hour sessions throughout the school year (Approx 30 sessions)

May ½ Term Assessment (2 days)

Uniq Summer School (4 days)

September Mock Examinations (Start of Year 6 for students) (2 dates)

Parents are welcome to opt for all aspects of the course, or, alternatively, to choose the elements of the course which they feel are appropriate for their child. It is worth noting that, where demand exceeds the places available, first priority will always be given to students who are attending our weekly sessions which occur throughout the year.

The course will continue for students who may be considering applications to Independent schools. In these instances there will be a continuation of weekly sessions throughout the autumn term of Year 6, with the nature of the course content changing slightly to reflect the requirements of the assessments. There will also be the opportunity for examination practice prior to the January exams and, additionally, interview guidance and practice for students.
