Standard of Appearance

Boy's hair must be kept short, tidy and uncoloured / Girls hair must be kept tidy and uncoloured with all hair accessories worn in accordance with school colours (Navy, Royal Blue or Gold).

Boys are not permitted to wear earrings and girls may only wear 'studs' in pierced ears. Pupils are not permitted to wear makeup or jewellery. **Mobile phones must not be brought into school.** We reserve theright to confiscate mobile phones if they are brought into school.

Please ensure that school blazers are worn to school. The regulation colour for winter coats is plain Navy Blue. Whilst school coats are optional, if they are worn, they must be plain and Navy Blue.

Pupils are not permitted to wear large or 'ear stretching' ear rings or piercings on any other parts of the body.

Jewellery must not be worn to school.

Mobile phones are not permitted in school.

Chewing gum is not permitted in school.

Skirts must be unpleated and knee length or below.

Make up must not be worn to school.

Pupils are also expected to have their natural hair colour.

School bags should also be in the school's regulation colour of Navy Blue or Black.

The school reserves the right to request that a pupil is collected and taken home for breaching the school's rules and regulations regarding uniform which upholds the school's ethos and principles. It is unfair to those that follow the rules and regulations to allow others to consistently breach these regulations. School uniform is compulsory and the wearing of it must be adhered to strictly.

Please ensure that your child/children are in the full and correct uniform.

Should you have any difficulty acquiring items, please notify the school office as we have some good quality used items in stock.



School Nurse Service

Please be aware that only medicine prescribed by a doctor can be administered within the school. The school has a number of qualified first aiders and a comfortable medical room.
