

Vonolel

Vonolel was a nimble grey Arab horse belonging to Field Marshal Lord Roberts. He carried his master on the 300-mile march from Kabul to Kandahar during the Second Afghan War.

Vonolel was a nimble grey Arab horse belonging to Field Marshal Lord Roberts. The pair were a perfect match: Lord Roberts was only 1.2m tall and Vonolel was a little bigger than a pony. Vonolel was Robert's only reliable mount and carried his master on the 300-mile march from Kabul to Kandahar during the Second Afghan War. Vonolel was awarded three medals for his service from Queen Victoria and had the honour of being in the procession for her Diamond Jubilee in 1897.
