The Parent Information Portal is a brand new platform designed to give you digital access to manage your appointments with your Health Visitor, School Nurse or Family Nurse, if you receive your care from Southern Health NHS Foundation Trust (SHFT).

# HOW TO SIGN UP: A STEP BY STEP GUIDE
