YSS is an independent charity that works with some of the most marginalised people in society. These include children as young as seven who are acting as young carers, families who need additional support and people coming out of prison. YSS is there to support and empower people to make positive choices and have better lives. Many of the people we help have little of what most of us take for granted – whether that is a roof over our head, positive family relationships, strong friendships, good health or financial resilience.

What is Skills4Life?

In partnership with the Smallwood Trust, YSS is running a two year project, Skills4Life, aimed at women aged 18 years and over who want to improve their financial knowledge and resilience. A fifth of women – around 5.1 million – live in poverty in the UK, compared to 4.4 million men. As women are often the sole carer for families, their financial resilience greatly impacts on children.

How can Skills4Life help?

Skills4Life can support women to become more financially independent and resilient. We will provide women with the knowledge, skills and confidence to manage their money effectively. Training around finances is provided along with resources to support your learning, and advice given to improve your financial situation. We will be running group sessions as well as providing one to one support remotely and in person.
