Permanent, respite or day care for people with Alzheimer's disease, other Dementia related illnesses, and / or physical health problems.

Clayfield care home has been established for nearly 40 years. It is situated in a residential area of Barnstaple, close to a regular bus service, shops and local amenities and within level walking distance of Rock Park and the River Taw.

Clayfield is a family run home providing residential care in a professional, caring and homely environment. All of our staff are chosen with care and are given appropriate training and supervision. We have experienced and mature care staff on duty throughout the day and night. The owner is an experienced nurse, and is on call at all times.

About Us

We aim to provide care and security whilst enabling our residents to maintain their optimum independence and peace of mind. Fun and Humour are encouraged and problems shared. Privacy is respected at all times and every resident can feel relaxed and secure being themselves yet benefiting from living as part of a small community. All cleaning and laundry is included in the service provided. Meals are considered to be a very important part of the day. All meals are freshly prepared and special diets can be catered for. Meals can be taken in the dining room, in the resident's own room or during clement weather, on the patio.



At Clayfield we work closely with District Nurses, Social Workers and Doctors as well as the family and other supporters of our residents. We are graded as good by CQC. At Clayfield we are always glad to receive applications from caring individuals for days, nights and weekend shifts.

Accommodation

Accommodation is provided on three floors, which are accessible by stair lifts. There are 14 single bedrooms (8 en suite) and 1 double or shared room is also available. All rooms have heating which can be individually regulated, hot and cold water, and a nurse call bell. At Clayfield we have invested in both a sophisticated nurse call bell system and care recording system. The recording system has many useful functions including the Relatives gateway. This allows relatives with the necessary permissions, to monitor the care of their loved one, on line.

There are two sitting/dining rooms & a reading/quiet room with an extensive large print library. There are three bathrooms and 2 toilets in addition to the en suites. One of the bathrooms has a hydrotherapy bath with hoist. There is also a "wet room" i.e. large shower room that allows users to have an assisted shower.

There is a kitchen on the ground floor and all our food is freshly prepared & cooked onsite by our wonderful catering staff. .

There is seating in the enclosed gardens to the front and rear of the property.
