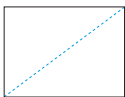

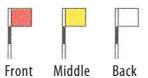


Stableford Points or Par Result

## 18 HOLE SCORECARD



### Local Rules

#### OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18)

A ball is out of bounds if it lies:

1. Beyond any boundary fence, wall, hedge or line.
2. Beyond any line marked by white posts.
3. On the clubhouse patio.

#### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

The following are designated as Immovable Obstructions:

1. All artificially covered pathways or tracks (shells, crushed granite, tarmac, plastic and rubble) are immovable obstructions. All other natural shingle pathways and tracks are integral parts of the course.
2. Tee steps.
3. Posts defining Penalty Areas.
4. All posts and rails and course furniture including distance marker posts.
5. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play, and is within two-club lengths of the putting green, and within two-club lengths of the ball. (Sprinkler Heads for example).
6. The fence between the 1st fairway and driving range.

#### ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16)

1. Ground under repair is marked with continuous white lines and/or signage.
2. Drainage lines on a fairway or in the rough are considered as GUR.

3. Tractor Marks in the General Area are treated as ground under repair from which free relief is allowed under rule 16.1f

#### PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

Penalty areas are defined by red or yellow stakes. Unmarked ditches are to be treated as Red Penalty Areas. The edge of unmarked Penalty Areas is where the ground breaks down.

#### STAKED TREES (Rule 16.1f)

Staked or sleeved trees supported by stakes are No Play Zones, and if a player's ball lies on or touches such a tree, or such a tree interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

#### PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

Match Play – Loss of hole  
Stroke Play – Two strokes

#### PLAYERS ADVISORY NOTICES

1. Players are requested to play "Ready Golf" as outlined in Rule 6.4, and to maintain a prompt pace of play as required by Rule 5.6
2. Please rake bunkers, replace divots, and repair pitch marks.
3. Priority on the course
  - a. Players on the 6th tee have priority over players on the 4th tee.
  - b. Players on the 18th tee have priority over players on the 13th tee.

### Defibrillator Code **C159**

4. All distance marker posts are to the centre of the greens:  
**Yellow & Black post 150 yards**  
**Red & White post 100 yards**
5. Respectful use of mobile phones on the Course or in the Clubhouse is permitted.
