

Spartan 2021 Venues

Wales – Glanusk Estate, Glanusk Park, A40, Crickhowell, NP8 1LP

19 - 20 June - Sprint (5K), Super (10K), Beast (21K), Trail (10K and Half-Marathon) and Kids

We are heading back to the beautiful Welsh countryside to kick off our epic 2021 season in style with the first of two triecta weekends. Put your fitness to the test by taking on the Sprint (5K), Super (10K) or Beast (21K) in the glorious Usk Valley of the famous Brecon Beacons National Park. Glanusk has something on offer for all running abilities and types, as it is also set to be the venue of our inaugural trail events (10K and Half-Marathon). The elevation gain of the Black Mountains make for one of our toughest courses to date, but it will all be worth it for the stunning views on offer. With varied terrain including woodlands, hills and rivers, you will take in a real taste of South Wales as well as getting a glimpse of some ancient Celtic Standing Stones and the old Tower Bridge over the River Usk.

Midlands – Marston Lodge, Marston Trussell, Market Harborough, LE16 9TT

24 - 25 June - Sprint (5k), Super (10K), Trail (10K and Half-Marathon) and Kids

You don't want to miss the opportunity to race at the home of Spartan UK and Ireland. Everyone loves Marston Lodge, and it just gets bigger and better year after year! The course lends itself perfectly to the Sprint (5K), Super (10K) and trail events on offer as it snakes between serene woodland, undulating terrain and the Event Village over and over again. However, don't be fooled into a false sense of security; this popular course changes every year and is surprisingly tougher than it looks. Be prepared for a few surprises! There's a reason it's our home; we love it, racers will love it.

Scotland – Hopetoun Estate, Queensferry, South Queensferry, EH30 9RW

25 - 26 September - Sprint (5K), Beast (21K), Ultra (50K) and Kids

We're mixing it up in 2021 by heading to the stunning Hopetoun Estate for the very first time. This historic venue offers something for everyone - race the Sprint (5K), Beast (21K) or go one step further and take on the Ultra (50K). The estate house was built at the turn of the 18th century in the idyllic surroundings of South Queensferry, on the outskirts of Edinburgh. Looking over the Forth of Firth, the venue boasts not only natural beauty but also many historic landmarks including ancient monuments and Castles. As with our previous Scotland venues, expect a challenging variation of terrain and elevation, with sections breaking out from winding woodland into open fields and then onto up-hill climbs.

London South East - Pippingford Park, Pippingford Estate, Nutley, East Sussex TN22 3HW

9 -10 October - Sprint (5K), Super (10K), Beast (21K) and Kids

Our second Triecta weekend! We return to the legendary, fan-favourite obstacle course racing venue of Pippingford Park. The iconic venue, which is still used by the British Army for Basic Training, is located in the stunning Ashdown Forest in the heart of the home county of Sussex.

With a perfect blend of trails, woodland, water, mud and open running, runners will snake through the most varied terrain we have in the calendar before crossing the finish line with an unsuspecting elevation gain. With a Beast (Half-Marathon), Super (10K) and Sprint (5K) on offer, it is the perfect location for first timers or those seasoned Spartans who want to race against the clock, so don't miss our 2020 season opener!

Twickenham - Twickenham Stadium, Whitton Road, Twickenham, TW2 7BA

11 December - Stadion (5K) and Kids

What a season finale we have in store! For only the UK's second ever Stadion (5K), we are bringing the adrenaline, fun and greatness of a Spartan race back to the awesome atmospheric venue that is the home of English rugby, the world-renowned Twickenham Stadium. The Spartan Stadion is a 5km, 20-obstacle race that offers a fresh challenge for all abilities, whether you're a new or seasoned racer. Throwing a number of exciting and unfamiliar obstacles in your paths, you will get the opportunity to experience a Spartan race on the same ground as legends tread, what's not to love?
