By ticking "I have read, understand and fully accept the Terms and Conditions " on the Booking Form, you accept & understand the following Terms & Conditions:

- For the named student to be photographed / recorded for appearance in videos / pictures / sound recordings for this Course.
- Your child's name will appear in the credits for this film.
- The film may be entered into film festivals and screened publicly. It may appear at our Cinema Screenings as well as for exciting marketing purposes for Worlds End Productions London and our associate company, PQA Enfield. Declining consent may however impact on your child's opportunities.
- All finished media will be accessible online after the course. This will include YouTube, Twitter, Facebook & Instagram.
- Duration of editing for film may vary and completion of works is at the discretion of Worlds End Productions London Ltd.
- Worlds End Productions London Ltd will take all reasonable steps to ensure storyline and script content is suitable and appropriate for the age groups involved.
- Worlds End Productions London film courses are subject to minimum attendance. If there are insufficient numbers to run the named course, a full refund will be issued.
- Any participant may be asked to leave the course if he/she is jeopardising the safety or enjoyment of others or their educational experience. In any such case, no refund will be given.
- All participants, W.E.P. L. staff and teachers reserve the right to be treated with respect and consideration. W.E.P.L. does not tolerate rude, offensive or aggressive remarks or behaviour in any way. All participants & their parents must be aware of the health and safety rules of the venue and comply with the recommendations at all times.
- Bullying, harassment, abuse or other inappropriate behaviour by participants/parents/guests will not be accepted and will result in the immediate removal of the participant from the course and such other legal remedies as may be available. In any such case, no refund will be given.
- Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) or the bringing or consumption of alcohol or the use or being under the influence of illegal substances is not permitted at any location used during the course. Failure to comply will result in the removal of the participant from the course. In any such case, no refund will be given.

Cancellations and Amendments

- Changes will become effective on the date of written confirmation being received.
- In the event of an individual named on the booking form cannot attend, we will accept substitution of another, appropriate, delegate on the condition that written notification of the substitution has been received by us at least 24 hours prior to the course start date date.
- The appropriate cancellation charge will apply based on the cost of your booking, as shown below.
- Worlds End Productions London film courses are subject to sufficient numbers booked on the course, and we aim to provide 14 days cancellation notice to all customers who have paid for any of these courses should we not receive enough bookings. In the unlikely event of W.E.P.L. cancelling the course or event in which you've paid for at any time, you will receive a full refund.

In the event of a parent/student cancelling their booking, the following refunds will be made:

Calendar days notice before the start date of the course & refund applicable

- 29 calendar days or more: Full refund
- Between 15 and 28 calendar days (inclusive): 50% refund
- Between 1 and 14 calendar days (inclusive) No refund will be given
- Failure to attend: Treated as late cancellation and no refund given
