

British Menopause Training Management of the Menopause Certificate

This evidence-based menopause education, developed by healthcare professionals for healthcare professionals, is peer reviewed and incorporates recommendations for best practice from both national and international guidelines.



Open to:

The certificate is open to eligible registered health care professionals, learners will be required to confirm their professional registration. Each Primary Care Network is eligible for one funded place.

Funding Available:



Surrey Heartlands will fund the cost for the online British Menopause Society, and Management of the Menopause Certificate. The training comprises of approximately five days of education.

In addition to the cost of the training, Surrey Heartlands will fund two days of associated primary care backfill related to support the participation in the training at a maximum cost of £1536. Evidence regarding the costs incurred will be required to access this part of the funding. Funding for backfill and the course fee of £875 will be reimbursed via invoicing from the GP practice. and must be claimed prior to the **31**st **March 2026.**

If you feel that you meet the requirements to access the funding, then please complete the expression of interest form by clicking on the <u>link</u>, which will take you to the EOI form. The deadline for submissions is: 11th August 2025.

The BMS Management of the Menopause Certificate is a complete online education package that enables eligible healthcare professionals to develop the confidence needed to deal with 95% of patients who walk through their door, leaving only the 5% of complex cases to be referred for specialist menopause care.
