Care Navigation Training

Practice and PCN managers are now being asked to nominate one member of staff, ideally reception staff and care navigators involved in triaging requests, to complete the virtual care navigation training.

The <u>delivery plan for recovering access to primary care</u>, published last month, committed to training 6,500 staff (one person from every practice in the country) in care navigation skills. Managers can book on nominated individuals now and on completion, individuals will be confident to communicate effectively with patients and to signpost to the most relevant team member or local services depending on patient needs. An advanced training offer will be available at a later date for those with experience of care navigation who can support and embed it into practices and networks for sustainability and standardisation.
