The Hidden Workload Study

The Hidden Workload Study is conducted by the Primary Care Academic CollaboraTive (PACT). PACT wants to better understand the daily workload of clinicians who work in general practice, especially the large amount of work that clinicians do other than seeing patients in planned consultations. This is often referred to as the "hidden" workload.
