#### **Update on Training Hub Projects 25-26**

As a Training Hub we continue to strive towards our mission of transforming and developing the Primary Care workforce through high quality education and training and as such we are always looking to evaluate and improve our offers alongside navigating changing funding streams and deliverables. Our funding is secured through the ICB approval processes and so we are required to submit proposals each year to request funds for all our projects. These include Protected Learning Time (PLT) and Education and Training offers. Historically we have commissioned various training providers for a range of clinical courses, enabling the Primary Care workforce to attend at no cost to practices. Not all Training Hubs operate like this and we are proud that we have been able to continue this for as long as we have. We are now in the position where we need to evaluate our training courses, agree contracts with providers, and consider cost effective sustainability going forwards. With regards to PLT, we recognise its value and are keen to evaluate the 24-25 model which was new this year to ensure continuous improvement.



We are working hard to do this as soon as possible but ask that in the meantime you bear with us until we can confirm future funding for this project. There will likely be a pause after April in the delivery of some Education and Training events as well as in PLT provision and so ask for your patience and continued engagement with new plans.
