

This programme improves patient safety by strengthening the emergency preparedness of all Primary Care staff (clinical and operational) through simulation training and is provided by a unique multiprofessional faculty of healthcare professionals working in primary care. It has been delivered insitu to individual GP practices, as well as to Primary Care Networks and GP

This half day training aims to support primary care staff prepare for medical emergencies by:

- Practicing emergency scenarios in a safe environment.
- Testing local systems, processes and equipment (when in-situ).
- Exploring critical roles for all staff during an emergency in Primary Care.
- Understanding team dynamics during an emergency event, building effective teamwork across roles, and generating a culture of support within the team.
- Generating confidence in providing lifesaving interventions.
