<u>Chichester District Foodbank - by referral only</u>

Chichester District Foodbank provides 3-day food parcels and support to anyone who is facing a financial crisis and has little or no money for basics, including food, toiletries and household items. There is no cost, but you will need to be referred by an organisation that holds our vouchers like the Citizens Advice. Further details can be found on their <u>website</u> or you can phone our office 01243 773687.

Once you have a voucher you can contact Chichester District Foodbank Centre in Petworth or Midhurst to arrange a delivery.
