The municipal vet Nefeli Damigou continues to support PAWS throughout the year and worked 2 days a month at the clinic. Although being kept busy at her own clinic she still found time to cover emergencies on stray cats and support our education programme. PAWS is very grateful to Nefeli for all her hard work.

Two UK teams volunteered for 2 weeks – Mike Houlihan & Mandy Cooper in the Spring and Janet Brenton & Karen Hancock in the Autumn. Both teams were supported by friends and family and PAWS was delighted that student Katie Bates joined up with the autumn team. A special thank you to Janet & Karen who neutered 126 cats and one dog in 9 days as well as Karen collecting £730.20 from her close friends and colleagues.... AMAZING!

Many thanks to all the volunteers on Paxos who helped the PAWS teams throughout the year. Excellent work by everyone and the figures for the year are:

In total PAWS vet teams dealt with 492 animals, neutered 368 cats and 18 dogs and carried out 28 other operations.... a great result!

Winter Feeding

PAWS has again made a substantial contribution to winter feeding of cats in the winter of 2019/20.

Frances Lister and Suzy Russell very kindly collected money from all the collection boxes on Paxos. With help from Kate Sams, fund raising certificates will be handed out in the Spring. Frances is passionate about caring for the cats on Paxos and does an excellent job distributing the winter-feeding money where it is most needed. Nowhere on the island is neglected. PAWS would also like to thank the many people that are part of the winter-feeding rota — their help is invaluable.

Thanks also to all the tourists who donate cat food and money to PAWS throughout the season as this helps considerably towards feeding costs.

Stray Dogs and Rescues

We would like to thank everyone who helped with rescuing dogs and cats in 2019, but sadly PAWS does not have the infrastructure or the finances to be a rescue and re-homing organisation. In order to help with abandoned dogs and puppies PAWS has introduced a **Dog Neutering Voucher Scheme**. With the support of the private vets and the approval of the municipality, an **80 euro** discount for dog neutering is available for all privately owned dogs. PAWS will neuter for free any stray dogs that are brought to the PAWS clinic or subsidise any neutering of a dog owned by a family with financial difficulties. We are very grateful to GAR who have already donated £3000 towards this project

Plans for 2020

3 vet teams have been arranged for 2020: Glen Watson – March 25th – April 8th Janet Brenton & Karen Hancock – September 23rd – October 7th Mike Houlihan & Mandy Cooper – October 17th – October 31st

John Durrant has once again offered maintenance services – he will renovate and paint all the feeding stations during the first week of May.

Albert Walker of AW anaesthesia will visit the PAWS clinic in April and service the anaesthetic machine and fit a new oxygen concentrator. PAWS is very grateful to Mr Walker who has given us a very good price for the new equipment and offers his services free of charge. PAWS has applied to Jean Sainsbury for a grant to pay for the new oxygen concentrator.

Nefeli will continue to work at the PAWS clinic 1 or 2 days each month and will cover emergencies with stray animals.

Kelly Craig will design more educational ideas and events for both children and adults on Paxos
