Bergerie de la Bastide Blanc (France) 125ml £5.30 / 175ml £7.95/ 500ml £20.75 / Bottle £29

This interesting blend of Grenache Blanc and Chardonnay, reveals typical notes of dried herbs, fennel and white flowers, with a touch of citrus that enhance the balance and the crisp finish.

Trebbiano d'Abruzzo "Frentano" (Italy) 125ml £5.50/ 175ml £8.25 / 500ml £21.45 / Bottle £30

Pale yellow in colour, the nose is delicate and fresh with hints of white flowers, peach and apple-blossom fruit. The palate is attractively fresh with notes of yellow plums, pears and apples

Good Hope (Unoaked) Chardonnay (SA) 125ml £5.85/ 175ml £8.75 / 500ml £22.85 / Bottle £32

This unoaked Chardonnay is an easy-drinking yet classy, affordable wine with more freshness, elegance and depth than commercial methods customarily permit. This Chardonnay has complexity and texture while still retaining the verve of the vineyards.

Terre d'Or Sauvignon Blanc (France) 125ml £6.75/ 175ml £10.40 / 500ml £26.45/ Bottle £37

A fresh, aromatic white wine selected from small parcels of Mediterranean hillside vineyard where chalky soils allow the Sauvignon Blanc to express its vibrant natural aromatic character.

Picpoul de Pinet, Rocs Blances (France) 125ml £7.30/ 175ml £10.95 / 500ml £28.60/ Bottle £40

Golden yellow in colour, on the palate fresh peach and a hint of hazelnut. Excellent with caviar and fish.

Rose

Cinsault Rosé, Henri Nordoc, Languedoc (France) 125ml £5.50/ 175ml £8.25 / 500ml £21.45 /Bottle £30

Drink cold in order for the wine to express its fruity flavours. Ideal as an aperitif but equally good with nibbles, grilled chicken, salmon and salads.

Château d'Ollières Rosé, Provence (France) 125ml £8.60/ 175ml £13.00 / 500ml £33.50 / Bottle £47

Bright salmon pink in the glass, the wine has good freshness, juicy red fruit and cinnamon and peppercorn spice.

Piquepoul Noir, Languedoc (France) 125ml £9.00 / 175ml £14.50 / 500ml £35 / Bottle £50

Pale pink in the glass, fresh and elegant, summer berries and fresh citrus notes leaving a crisp finish.

Whispering Angel Rosé, Provence (France) Bottle £70 / Magnum £150

Pale pink in the glass with a perfumed bouquet of elegant summer fruits and floral nose, fresh red berries and hints of cherries.

Rouge

Bergerie de la Bastide rouge (France) 125ml £5.30 / 175ml £7.95/ 500ml £20.75 / Bottle £29

Savoury assemblage using mainly grenache and merlot. Light, fresh and clean on the palate sweet red fruits and vanilla flavours.

Henri Nordoc Merlot, Languedoc, (France) 125ml £5.50/ 175ml £8.25 /500ml £21.45 /Bottle 30

Merlot is the perfect accompaniment to beef - try with a rump steak and herb stuffing, braised beef olives or steak and oyster pie.

Rioja Vina Albergada (Spain) 125ml £5.85/ 175ml £8.75 / 500ml £22.85 / Bottle £32

Fruity wine, fresh and intense aromas and pleasant mouthfeel, Live garnet colour with cherry red tones and sparkling ruby

Pinot Noir, L'Artiste (France) 125ml £6.75 / 175ml £10.40 / 500ml £26.45 / Bottle £37

A light cherry red colour with ruby reflections. On the palate morello cherry and red currant with a floral sensation. Pairs elegantly with roasted vegetable dishes or seafood and roasted chicken

Malbec, Highest Point (Argentina) 125ml £7.30 / 175ml £10.95 / 500ml £28.60/ Bottle £40

Lovely supple tannins and bold fruit, but never over-egged, this has a lovely balanced freshness and approachability.
