STALLHOLDER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Once you are accepted by the Organisers a confirmation email will be sent together with an invoice. Payment will be required in order to confirm your pitch and will be non-refundable unless the event is cancelled.
- 2. The Organisers reserve the right to select which applications are accepted in order to preserve a balance of stalls without too much duplication. However, we cannot guarantee exclusivity for any items on sale.
- 3. The number of hot food pitches and licensed bars are limited.
- 4. If there are infringements, we reserve the right to cancel and no monies will be refunded.
- 5. The Gig on the Green exists to raise funds for improving the sports facilities that are being developed around Yateley United FC at Sean Devereux Park.
- 6. The event is licensed for a maximum of 5,000 visitors per day. We do not guarantee volumes of visitors. Sunday tends to be a smaller event than Saturday in terms of numbers attending.
- 7. Pitches will be as indicated in the application form and includes one parking space behind the stall.
- 8. Pitch location will be allocated by the organisers.
- 9. Food and beverage stalls can be erected on Friday.
- 10. All other stalls will be allowed on site from 08:30hrs on the Saturday. All stalls must be erected in situ and all other vehicles removed from site by 10:30hrs. Gates open at midday.
- 11. On Saturday stalls may close at 19:00hrs and be escorted off site by security at 20:00hrs. This is the only early exit time. Site closes at 23:00hrs.
- 12. On Sunday, the site will open from 09:00hrs. Stall holders are requested to be in situ by 12:00hrs. There is no early exit on Sunday. The event closes at 19:30hrs. All stall holders should vacate the event no later than 22:00hrs.
- 13. When travelling in the arena please use your hazard lights. When leaving the site please do not move your vehicle without prior consent from the organisers.
- 14. Wristbands will be issued on the day by the organisers fees are noted on the reverse. The wristbands are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 15. Electrical power will not be provided
- 16. Amplified music may not be played.
- 17. All stall holders must be aware of the needs of the public and those with disabilities.
- 18. Stall holders are responsible for their own security and safety of their stalls, equipment and staff.

- 19. Organisers will ensure that you comply to the Health and Safety and approved code of practices and reserve the right to remove you, if you fail to comply.
- 20. Yateley Sports CIC will not be responsible for any damage or theft caused to the stall or its contents
- 21. In the unlikely event of a security event please inform security, do not attempt to manage the unwanted event yourself.
- 22. Under no circumstances are pets allowed on the site.
- 23. All stall holders must clear their own rubbish and surrounding pitch after the festival. Skips are located next to the Tythings.
- 24. All stall holders must provide Public Liability Insurance, Health & Safety Documentation and their own Risk assessment. Any electrical/gas items may be checked by the organisers for suitability.
- 25. Strictly no selling of alcohol (except for the authorised bars) or cigarettes.
- 26. The event is subject to licence.
