

Edge Dynamics Psychology is a founder level psychological lineage centred on the idea that transformation occurs at thresholds where identity meaning and symbolic structure destabilise and reorganise.

Developmental Edge is the threshold where historical identity meets emerging identity and disavowed developmental material and existential pressure surface. Relational Edge is the field level threshold where intimacy conflict shame and power reorganise relational contact. Symbolic Edge is the threshold where archetypal and imaginal forces emerge and reshape meaning and symbolic coherence. Practitioner Edge is the practitioner threshold where shadow aspiration and symbolic countertransference become active in the field. Internal Edge is the inner threshold where unconscious material symbolic forces and identity structures collide and create internal destabilisation and reorganisation.

Field Dynamics refers to the relational symbolic and developmental forces shaping psychological events. Field Activation is the intensification of field forces signalling an emerging edge. Field Contraction is the tightening or collapse in the field often expressed through shame or withdrawal. Field Signals are subtle cues indicating an approaching threshold.

Internal Threshold is the inner moment where identity destabilises. Internal Destabilisation is the fragmentation or pressure signalling an internal edge. Internal Reorganisation is the restructuring of inner meaning at the threshold. Internal Symbolic Activation is the emergence of archetypal or imaginal forces within the psyche.

Contact Boundary is the threshold where relational contact reorganises. Conflict Edge is conflict experienced as a transformational threshold. Shame Edge is shame functioning as a field contraction and symbolic signal. Erotic Edge is erotic energy emerging as a field phenomenon. Power Edge is the reorganisation of power dynamics within the relational field.

Symbolic Intelligence is the capacity to track archetypal and imaginal forces. Archetypal Activation is the emergence of archetypal patterns at the edge. Imaginal Material is symbolic content arising from the unconscious.

Symbolic Countertransference is the practitioner symbolic response used diagnostically. Practitioner Aspiration is the practitioner developmental and symbolic longing. Practitioner Shadow is disavowed practitioner material active at the edge. Field Level Leadership is leading from the field rather than technique.

Edge Threshold is the moment meaning destabilises. Threshold Reorganisation is the process of symbolic and relational restructuring. Destabilisation Event is a field event signalling imminent transformation. Symbolic Reorganisation is the restructuring of meaning at the symbolic edge.

Modality Boundary distinguishes Edge Dynamics from other modalities. Lineage Architecture defines the school as a lineage rather than a technique. Non Technique Orientation states that transformation occurs at thresholds rather than through methods. Non Intrapsychic Orientation states that internal edges are symbolic thresholds rather than parts or schemas.
