

Questions & Answers...

Can children with additional needs join in all activities?

All of the activities have all been adapted to be fully inclusive, for example there is a lower edge to the ponds so children in wheelchairs can enjoy pond dipping. All activities are fully accessible.

Do we need an activity co-ordinator for all activities?

No. An activity co-ordinator will be available for part of the time on your stay. You will have free time as well to independently access some of the activities.

How many people can stay in the adapted lodge?

Groups of up to 16 people (including parents and carers) can stay at any one time.

How long can the lodge be hired out for?

The day, weekend, week long stays and more.

How much is it to hire the lodge?
